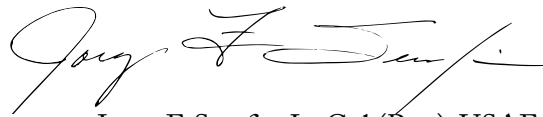


## EDITORIAL
