## CHAPLAIN, COLONEL RALPH T. ELLIOTT JR.

Chaplain, Colonel Ralph T. Elliott Jr., currently serves as the Commandant, Air Force Chaplain Corps College, Ira C. Eaker Center for Leadership Development, Maxwell Air Force Base, Montgomery, Alabama. He leads an elite team of 24 Total Force Chaplains and Religious Affairs Airmen and one civilian Airman. On behalf of the Air Force Chief of Chaplain's Office, the College trains and educates the nearly 2,000 chaplains and religious affairs Airmen from the active duty, Air Reserve, and Air Guard components to provide worship, liturgies, religious rites and spiritual care to all Air and Space professionals and their families while also serving as the primary adviser to commanders and senior enlisted leaders on moral, spiritual, ethical, and religious matters.

Chaplain Elliott served in the enlisted corps as an Airborne Warning and Control Systems (AWACS) technician and Religious Affairs Airman from 1994 to 2000. He received a direct commission as a Chaplain Candidate in 2001 and while serving as a Candidate, he completed a unit of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE)



at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, in Washington D.C. Chaplain Elliott re-entered active duty in 2003 as a Chaplain. He deployed to U.S. Air Forces Central Command in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM, IRAQI FREEDOM and JOINT TASK FORCE HORN OF AFRICA (JTFHOA). Prior to attending Air War College Chaplain Elliott served in a four-star sub unified command as Deputy Command Chaplain for United States Forces Korea (USFK) HQ at Camp Humphreys, Republic of Korea. Chaplain Elliott received his ordination and ecclesiastical endorsement from the National Baptist Convention, USA Inc.
