COLONEL MATTHEW E. TIPTON

Colonel Matthew E. Tipton is the Director, Air Force Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps, Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama. He is responsible for the Air Force's high school citizenship training program comprised of about 84,450 students and 1,600 instructors at approximately 830 high schools worldwide. Colonel Tipton directs staff initiatives and policy to implement the world's largest and most comprehensive aerospace science education program.

Colonel Tipton received his commission in 2003 through the Air Force Reserve Officers' Training Corps at the University of Alabama. After graduating from Combat Systems Officer Training at Randolph AFB, he was assigned as an electronic warfare officer to the EC-130H COMPASS CALL. Colonel Tipton has had a variety of operational and staff assignments, including squadron command. He has deployed to support air operations over Iraq and Afghanistan.

Prior to his current assignment, Colonel Tipton served as the Deputy Director for Strategy and Concepts at the LeMay Center for Doctrine Development.
