The 31st Student Squadron "Bulls" provide Professional Military Education to more than 600 Air and Space Force Captains, International Officers, and Department of the Air Force Civilians annually.

Prior to this assignment Lt Col Hewett served as the Commander, 502d Security Forces Squadron, Joint Base San Antonio, Ft. Sam Houston. As Commander, he was responsible for all law enforcement and security operations on three separate installations including Camp Bullis, Brooke Army Medical Center and Ft. Sam Houston. Prior to taking command Lt Col Hewett served as the Director for the Mission Support Group Commanders' Course hosted by Commanders' School at the Eaker Center based at Maxwell AFB, AL.
